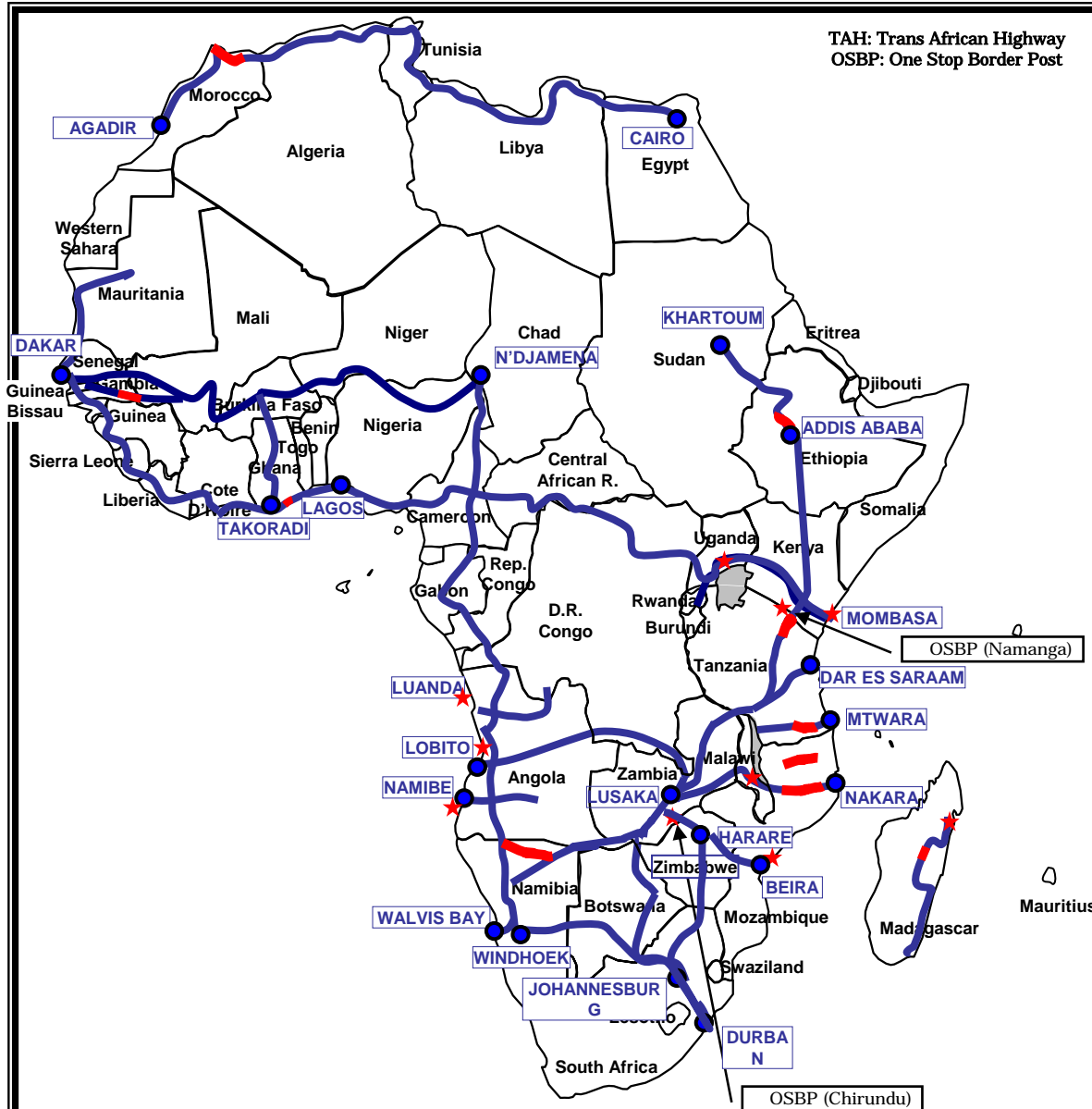

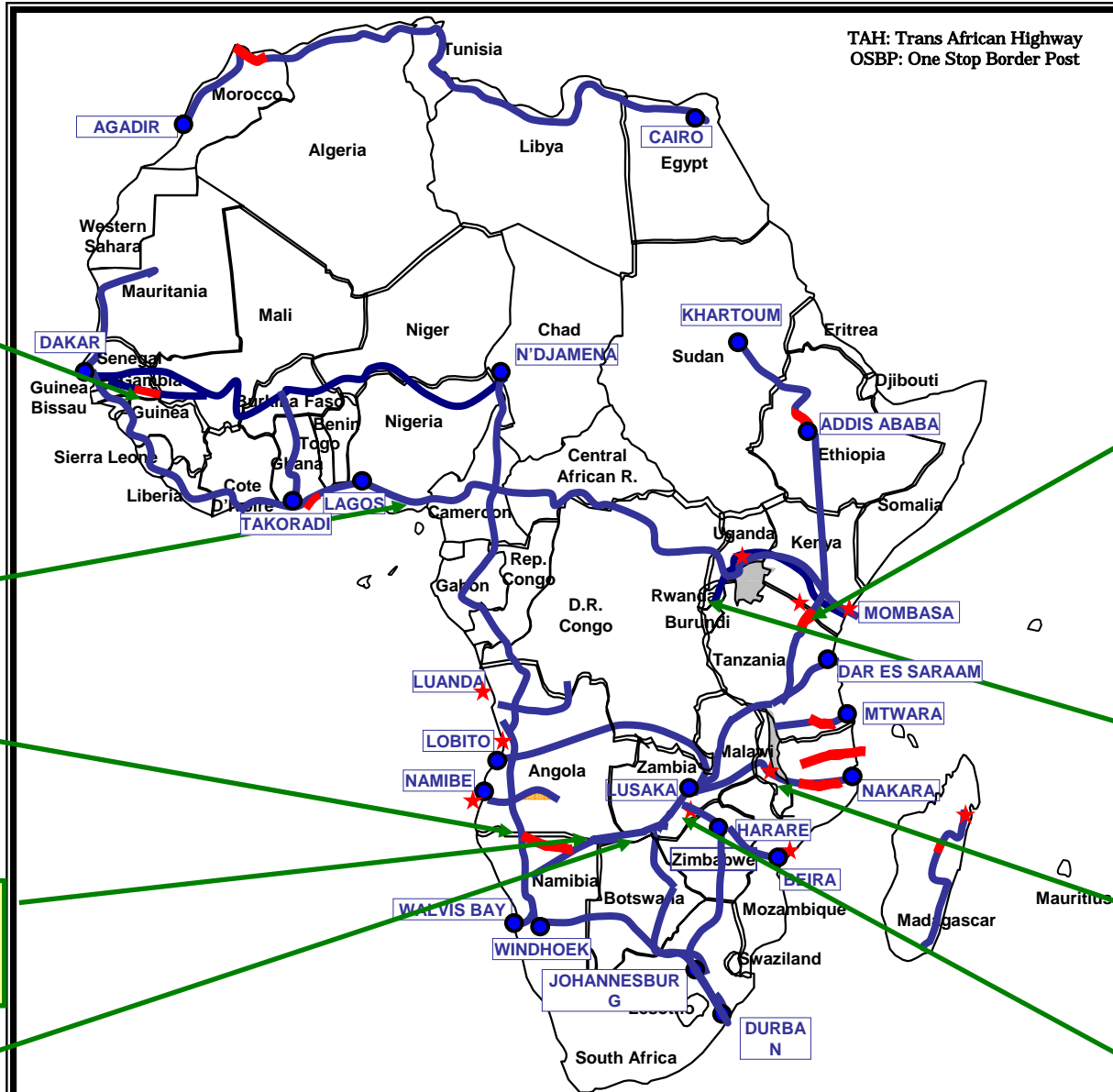

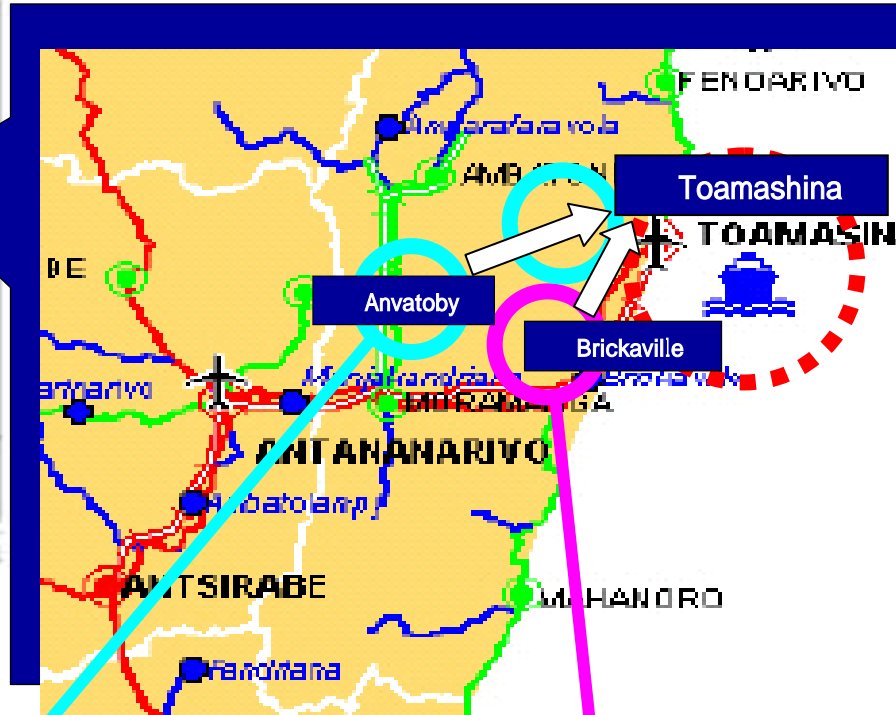

[Power Pool] The free trade of power within regions

There are 4 power pools in Sub-Sahara Africa, SAPP (South African Power Pool), EAPP (East African P P), WAPP (West African P P), CAPP (Central African P P). Exceptionally, in the case of significant power shortage within a pool, power has been traded among pools.

Case of PPP:

Toamasina Port (Madagascar)



Toamasina Port Development Project

This port is covering 70% - 80% of all cargos in Madagascar. The request of port development is expanding 3 piers, A, B and C.

JETRO: F/S implemented for 2.5 months from Dec, 2007.



JICA: received request for Study of Development in 2008 and adopted.



JICA: under consideration of ODA loans implementation after JETRO F/ S and JICA study.

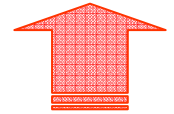

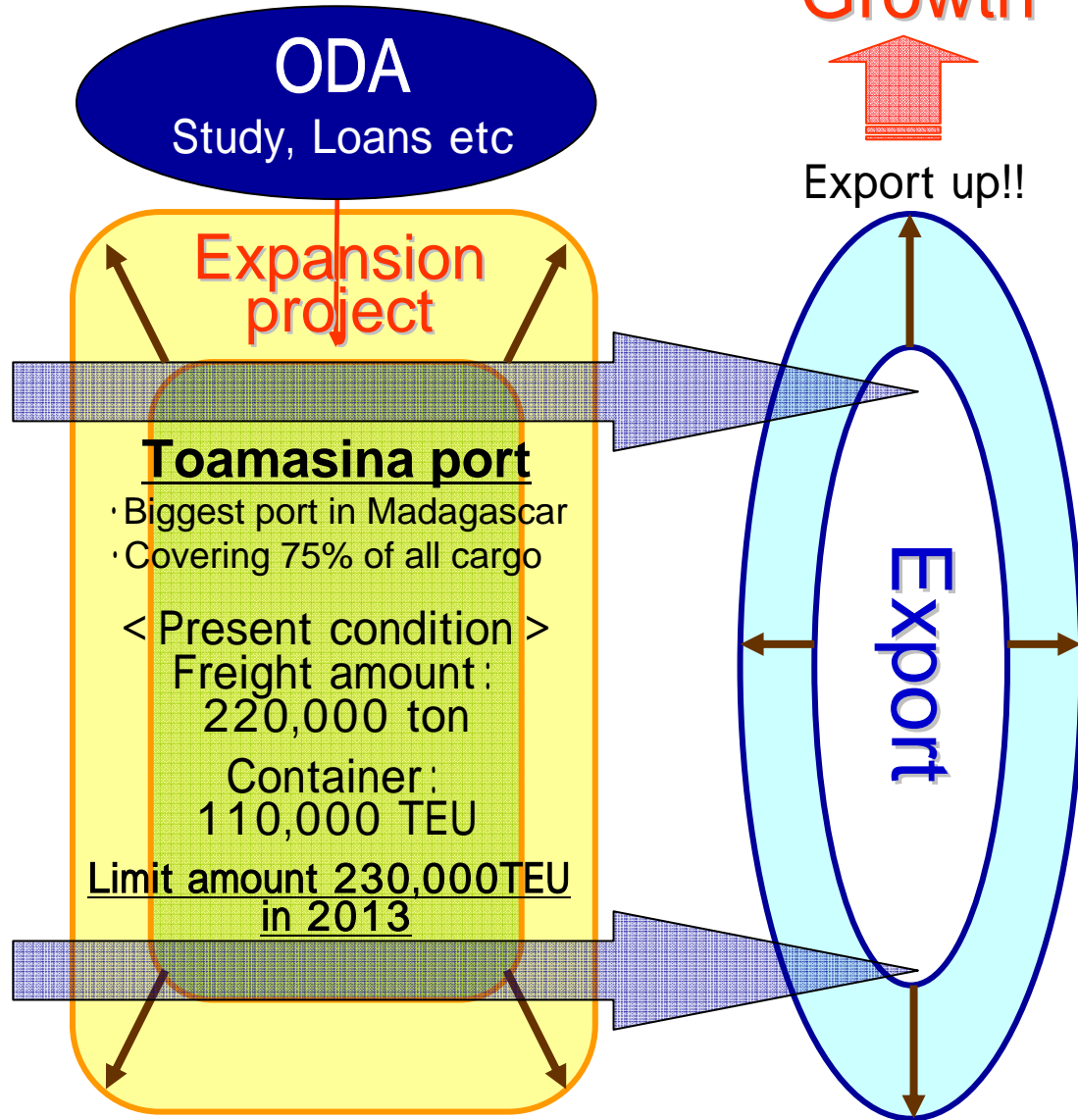
